Answers:

- Animals can be a source of medicines for humans.
- Some animals eat pests that destroy human food crops.
- Animals make up a large part of humankind's food supply.
- Some people feel it is morally wrong to allow a species to die out.
- Many animals serve as environmental monitors, warning us about growing pollution hazards.
- The loss of one endangered animal can have impact on an entire ecosystem.
- People enjoy being part of a natural world that includes many different kinds of animals.
